WHAT IS NATIONAL MOTORSPORT WEEK?

National Motorsport Week celebrates and promotes all forms of motorsport and the community making the sport thrive throughout the UK.

Marked annually, National Motorsport Week provides a call to action for the community to come together under the umbrella of a national event to activate and support the growth and development of motorsport.





OBJECTIVES

Motorsport UK seeks to use the week to:

- Raise awareness of motorsport and the ways in which people can access and engage with the sport
- Leverage the week to promote themes including, but not limited to: sustainability, accessibility, affordability, safety, propulsion, volunteering and diversity
- Support Motorsport UK's overarching aim of increasing membership in all roles and all levels of the sport





KEY MESSAGING

World Class Opportunities: Motorsport is a national pastime, and the UK are world leaders in motorsport with opportunities to get involved, up and down the country.

Sport for All: It's not just drivers. Motorsport can educate through STEM, build communities and establish lasting legacies nationwide. Behind every team, club and event, there are skilled individuals providing valuable support.

Thanks to the Volunteers: Our volunteers are the lifeblood of motorsport in the UK. Without their involvement our sport would not be a success. Volunteering provides unique opportunities and experiences that must be celebrated.

Cheap, easy, everywhere: It's straightforward to get started or get involved in motorsport. It is simpler, cheaper and closer than you think, so why wait!





WHEN IS IT?

National Motorsport Week will run over two consecutive weekends and will typically be held after the British Grand Prix and coincide with Goodwood Festival of Speed.

11-21 JULY 2024

This year's event starts with Goodwood Festival of Speed and concludes with the FIA Formula E London E-Prix, with at least another 100 Motorsport UK permitted events taking place. The week will cover multiple disciplines and enable a showcase of the best motorsport events throughout the UK.

Motorsport UK encourage clubs to activate locally, competitors and volunteers to engage on social media and bring friends and family into the sport, and the government / industry to show support through engagement.

- Events: Run an event under the National Motorsport Week banner and registering it with Motorsport UK for the website
- Taster Events: Could you add a taster permit to an event you are already running?
- Promote: Promote affiliation to National Motorsport Week through a press announcement, which we can collaborate on.





HOW YOU CAN GET INVOLVED

Utilise your Social Media channels to help spread the word.

- **Content**: Utilise the provided National Motorsport Week assets and create content across owned channels
- Inform: Tell local communities and fans of the campaign and the ways in which people can get involved in the sport.
- **Call to Action**: Provide a clear call to action in promotional output, including offers, freebies and event opportunities to newcomers to the sport to try it, engage with it and share our passion for it
- Tell Us: Tell Motorsport UK what you're doing so we can align and where necessary, amplify and support through media matchmaking and tell stories across digital and social media.
